







Breakdown of the GBS Centers in Latvia

Most of GBS centers are BPOs from the Nordics (30%) with IT, customer care, financial and accounting services as dominating functions








Core services of a multifunctional GBS: customer care, finance, accounting, procurement, logistics.


Breakdown of the GBS Centers in Latvia







Incentives for Smart Company Growth

Government support for employee upskilling and knowledge transfer

Up to 50-60% of costs coverage capped at EUR 200 000 per project for professional trainings or knowledge transfer activities:

Eligible costs:

 Training course costs (implementation of digitalization, automation and robotization, specialized language courses, training materials etc.)

- Transportation and accommodation costs in Latvia and abroad.
- Salaries of employees during trainings.

Total available funding EUR 7,9 million Project duration: until 31.12.2023











Availability of Office Space in Riga
